Since 1991, we have been providing scholarships to recognized outstanding students attending college, first as the Foundation of the Wichita Falls Chapter of the Construction Specifications Institute and now as the Association of North Texas Construction Professionals. The scholarships, based on merit, are to be given to full time students of any classification who attend or who will attend college. Merit is interpreted by our selection committee as academic achievement, good citizenship and potential for service to society.

Applicants for the Association of North Texas Construction Professionals Scholarship should note the following:

- New applicants must submit transcripts of previous academic work, and application status. Beginning freshmen must submit entering test scores. New applicants must submit two letters of recommendation, using the enclosed form only, to the office of School Relations for consideration by a selection committee by the printed April 4 deadline.
- Scholarship amounts will be divided between the Fall and Spring semesters. Recipients will be notified in the last spring after the June 1 deadline of the award to be given the following Fall.
- Students who are current recipients must reapply by the printed June 1 deadline. To be reconsidered, the student must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of no less than 2.5 (undergraduate) or 2.75 (graduate).
- Scholarship may be renewed provided the student maintains the minimum cumulative grade point average and is a full time student each long semester term of enrollment and pursuing a degree. The student must successfully complete a minimum of twenty four (24) semester hours of credit by the end of the spring term of the awarded year.
- Preference will be given to those students who are engaged in or from families engaged in the construction trades.
